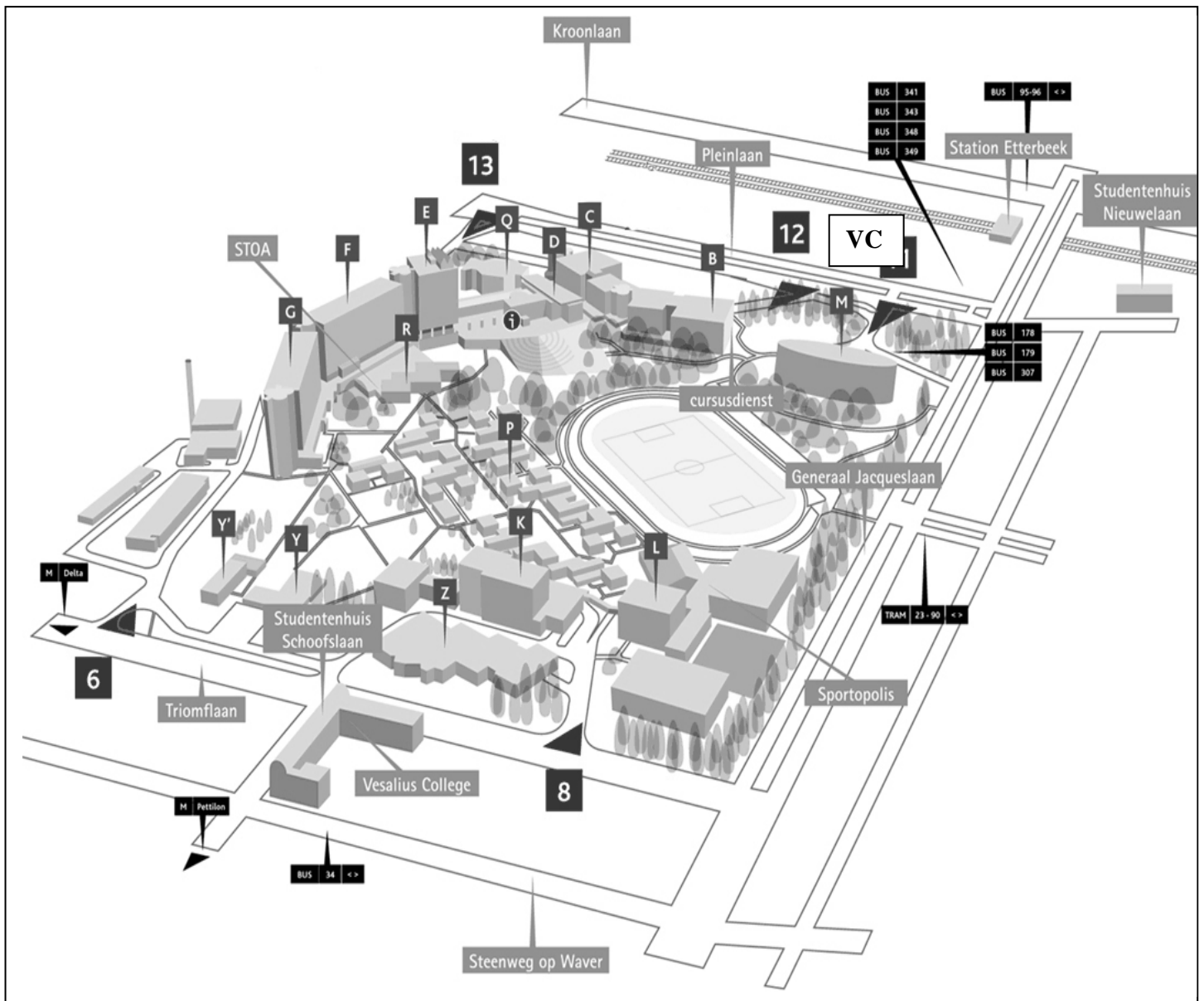
AS SOON AS YOU HAVE YOUR BELGIAN ADDRESS
