Tuition and Fees per Semester

Fall 2008 – Spring 2009

Application Fee

When students submit their application, they must include a non-refundable fee of 50.00 Euro (€). This fee is also applicable to Study Abroad students.

Transfer Credit Fee

For assessment of transfer credits there is a non-refundable transfer credit fee of €150.00, to be deducted from tuition upon registration.

Tuition and Fees for Full-time Students

Full-time Bachelor's degree students take 4 to 5 courses per semester.

Tuition and appropriate fees, as shown below, are payable in full, every semester, upon

registration (no later than the end of the first week of classes) unless the student has arranged for a deferred payment plan beforehand (for more details, see item 4 "Deferred Payment Plan").

The English for Academic Purposes (EAP) Programme is a full-time course and is charged at the full-time rate as for Bachelor's degree students.

¹ Late payment fees will be charged for any payments not made by the respective due date(s).

² Lab fees vary according to the courses for which the student registers.

³ This fee is only charged to students who enroll for the course "ART361E".

The College reserves the right to adjust the tuition and fees for Spring 2009 if there is a significant rise in inflation.

Tuition and Fees for Part-time Students

Part-time students take up to 3 courses and pay €1,500.00 per course. A minimum service fee of €170.00 is charged; this fee may be increased depending upon the service that the student requires. All other fees are also applicable for part-time students.

Methods of Payment

Payment may be presented in € by bank transfer or by credit card. After course enrollment and upon request, the Accounts Officer can provide you with an invoice stating the amount due.

1. By Bank Transfer

When transferring monies, please include your full name and specify the type of fee (for example Application Fee, Transfer Credit Fee, Tuition & Fees)

2. Transfer of Money From Abroad

Transferring money from abroad sometimes takes 2 or 3 months. It is important to retain proof of payment. To avoid problems, allow time for the payment to arrive before registration; at registration no bank orders will be accepted.

Students are liable for all bank charges, including exchange costs. In cases where Vesalius College pays these costs on behalf of the student, the student will be billed for the difference before the end of the semester.

3. By Credit Card

Vesalius College accepts Eurocard/Mastercard and Visa. Should the credit card not be in your name, then written and signed permission from the cardholder must accompany your payment.

You may pay the application fee by credit card by completing the section "Application Fee" on the application form or by sending us a letter authorizing us to charge your credit card.

4. Deferred Payment Plan (available to full-time students only)

The deferred payment plan allows students to pay the tuition for each semester in monthly installments during the semester, rather than in a lump sum at registration. A first payment of €2,575.00 is due at registration, and installments of €900.00 are due each month (an administrative fee of €25.00 for each payment is included). Lab fees are added to the second installment. For more details, please contact the Accounts Officer or the Admissions Office.

Students who intend to pay in this way should notify the Accounts Officer in writing before registration if at all possible.

Students whose payments are not in order are not allowed to register for the next semester, to take any examinations or to receive official documents or grades.
