Organisational Profile

Access to information technologies (IT) is no longer a luxury in the developing world as it has become primordial to promote improved educational and economic prospects. However, the cost of new equipment, limited infrastructure and the lack of IT knowledge and proficiency imply that many people are still deprived of access to IT.

Close the Gap is an international not-for-profit organisation that helps bridge this digital divide by donating cost-efficient high-quality second-hand IT-equipment to projects in the South. Socio-educational programmes such as schools, hospitals and other projects focusing on improvement of educational and information facilities can ask for Close the Gap's support.

Close the Gap wants to counter the digital divide and therefore collects computers from its donors, has the hard disks cleaned, the hardware checked and subsequently configured according to the requirements of its end-users. The computers are then shipped to the destination country by air or sea transport. Locally, they are incorporated in a support and maintenance programme to ensure good usage and sustainability.
